Custom Compounded Prescriptions for Men and Women

INFORMATION YOU MAY NEED WHEN FILING FOR INSURANCE REIMBURSEMENT

1. Check your insurance plan for coverage parameters.
2. Follow the instructions for claim submissions outlined by your insurance company.
3. The Women's International Pharmacy Prescription Information Sheet, enclosed with your prescription, contains important information that the insurance company will need in order to process your claim and can be included with your claim submission.
4. Make a copy of the claim information and submit as directed by your coverage plan.

INFORMATION YOU MAY NEED WHEN HANDLING A REJECTED CLAIM

- ✓ Confirm coverage parameters with your insurance administrator.
- ✓ Compounded drugs are legally recognized by all states as prescription drugs. Compounded drugs do not have and are not required to have FDA approval. Practitioners may prescribe them, pharmacists may compound them.
- ✓ National Drug Code (NDC) numbers are part of an identification system designed for manufactured pharmaceuticals and not chemicals or compounded items. Compounded medications do not have NDC numbers. The individual active ingredient(s) in the compound may or may not have an NDC number. We provide NDC number information for manufactured drugs and ingredients when available.
